

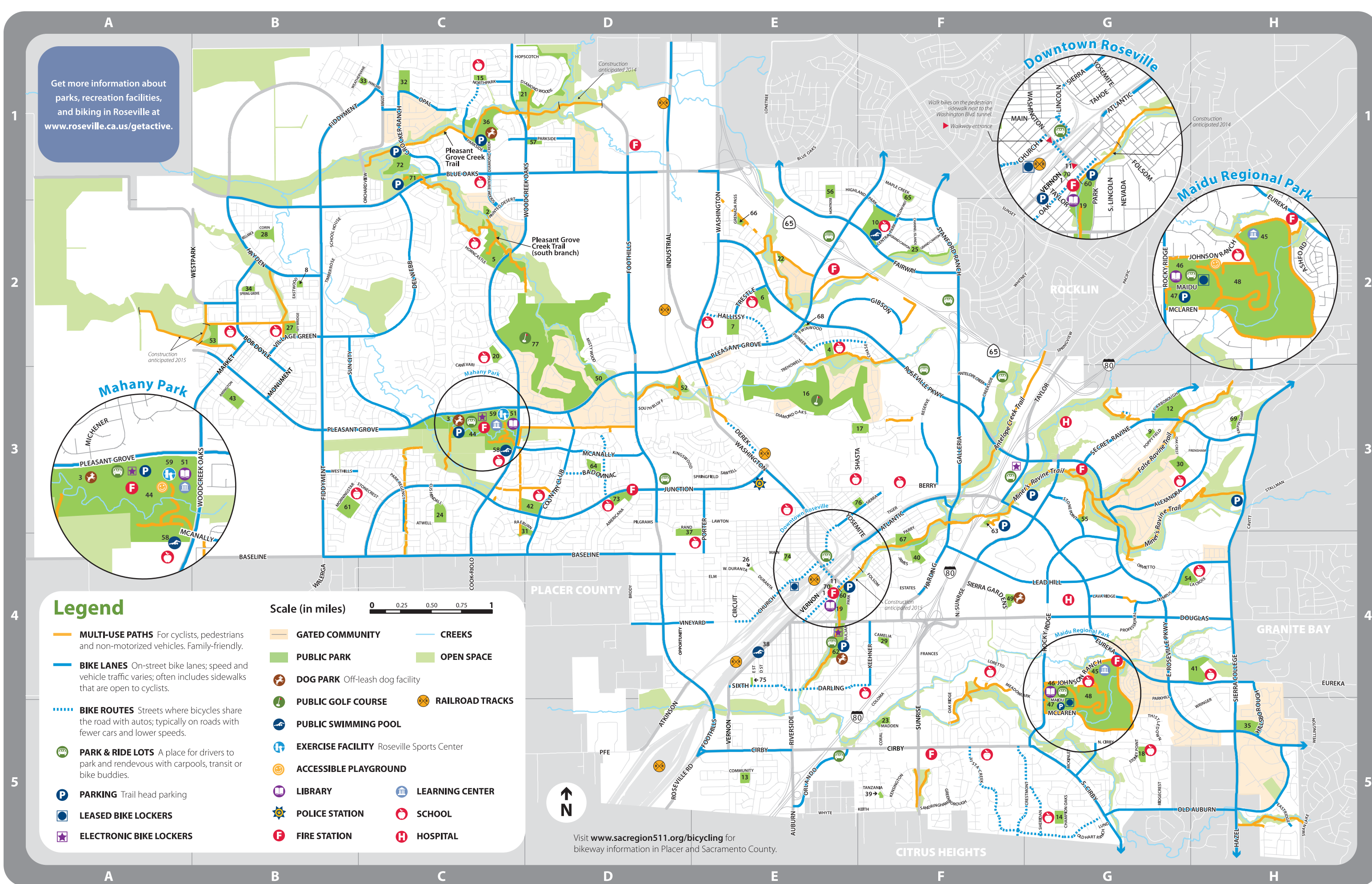
Miner's & False Ravine Trails

Walking Your Dog

Dog walking is allowed on designated multi-use paths. The law requires you to pick up after your pet and keep dogs on paved trails and on a maximum 6' length leash. Dogs are not allowed in City parks except: on permitted multi-use paths which pass through parks, when dogs are assistance animals, or in City dog parks.

Rules of the Road

- Wear a helmet
 - Obey all traffic signs and signals
 - Ride on the right
 - Ride predictably
 - Observe posted speed limits
 - Scan for traffic and signal lane changes and turns
 - Yield to pedestrians
 - Use lights at night
 - Ride single file

Share the Trail

- Be a responsible trail user.
- Don't block the trail
 - Keep dogs under control—6’ leash maximum
 - Travel at a safe speed
 - Pass with care
 - Bicyclists keep right except to pass
 - Pedestrians keep left to face oncoming cyclists
